General Show Rules:

1. **NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED** (dated on or after 10/23/05).
2. Entries open to all North Carolina Youth between the ages of 5-19 as of January 1, 2006.
3. All decisions made by the judge are final.
4. Show committee will make final decision as to eligibility of entries and classes
5. In accordance with Chapter 99E of the North Carolina Statutes, the Wayne County Livestock Development Association, D & H Saddle Club, and Wayne County Cooperative Extension are not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting exclusively from the inherent risk on equine activities.
6. No stallions will be shown.
7. The following age divisions will apply (as of Jan. 1, 2006):
 - Cloverbud: 5-8 years
 - Junior: 9-13 years
 - Senior: 14-19 years
8. Safety helmets will be required for leadline, hunter, games and adaptive riding classes. Western exhibitors may wear western hat or safety helmet. Hunter and western show attire will be required.
9. Adaptive riding is open to any youth currently enrolled in an adaptive riding program. Riders may have a horse handler and one to two side walkers if needed. An evaluation of the class entries will be made on show day to further determine riding levels and class requirements.
10. A pattern will be required for junior and senior showmanship, senior hunt seat and stock seat equitation, and trail. Patterns will be posted one hour before show time.
11. Showmanship will be judged on the exhibitor's execution of the pattern, as well as his/her appearance, fitting of the horse, tack and equipment.
12. Equitation classes will be judged on the rider's performance and horsemanship skills, including body position, use of hands and legs, ability to control the horse, and execution of the pattern. Each entry will individually execute the pattern.
13. Novice rider classes are open to exhibitors or horses with two or less years of showing experience.
14. Leadline is open to cloverbuds or therapeutic riders only. There will be no premiums for these classes.
15. Hunter Under Saddle will require horses to walk, trot, canter, and back, with light contact and without undue restraint.
16. Western Pleasure will require horses to walk, jog, lope, and back on a reasonably loose rein, without undue restraint.
17. Trail classes will be open to all riders, hunter and western.
18. Game classes will be timed events. Gaming participants are required to wear a safety helmet. Classes will start and stop inside the arena with a closed gate.

Directions to D & H Saddle Club Arena:

D&H Saddle Club Arena is just northwest of Goldsboro, approximately 3 miles from highway 70 in the Nahunta community

From the east:

Travel west on highway 70, towards Raleigh

After the intersection of highway 581/70, look for Musgrave Equipment on right

Turn right at Musgrave onto Capps Bridge Road (heading north)

At first intersection (2.4 miles), take a right onto Gurley Dairy Road

Go approximately .6 mile, turn left onto dirt road (horses on right and left)

Arena is down path on right

From the west:

Travel east on highway 70, towards Goldsboro

Just past the county line, turn left at Musgrave Equipment onto Capps Bridge Road (heading north)

Go 2.4 miles and turn at first intersection, take a right onto Gurley Dairy Road

Go approximately .6 mile, turn left onto dirt road (horses on right and left)

Arena is down path on right
